

Dr. DORJEE RAPTEN

Dr. Dorjee Raptan Neshar is born in Kyidong, Central part of Tibet in 1964. After the Chinese occupation of Tibet, he escaped to India with his families when he was only 5 year old.

Dr. Dorjee did his primary & secondary education in Central School for Tibetans in Mussoorie, North India. And after completing his All India Higher Secondary Education in Bachelor of Science in 1981, he joined Tibetan Medical College based in Dharamsala in 1981 where he completed his 5 years of intensive studies on Tibetan Medical System (TMS) with outstanding results. He received most of his higher medical initiations, empowerments & practical experience into the more profound level of health & healing through late Dr. Tenzin Cheodrak (the former chief physician to His Holiness The Dalai Lama) and some of the great spiritual Masters of the time.

In 1988, he took charge of the Tibetan Medical & Research Center at Bylakuppe in South India Tibetan Settlement. Having extended his healing services also towards nearby Indian towns & cities notably Mysore & Bangalore, in June 1991, encouraged by the positive healing benefits of Tibetan Medicine on local Indian & particularly in the treatment of cancer, Bangalore based Indian company called Kemwell International Pvt Ltd came sponsored the establishment of Tibetan Medical Centre in Bangalore city. Dr. Dorjee was then appointed as the chief medical officer in-charge & the senior consulting physician of the Bangalore Branch Medical Centre in 1991. His Bangalore Clinic receives patients from all across the world, neighboring states and cities especially to receive his cancer care & management therapies. Besides, he travels regularly for the monthly medical camps in Chennai, Kerala, Pondicherry, Hyderabad and South Tibetan Settlements catering to the health service of hundreds of local people there. His healing service, consultation and teachings on Tibetan medicine are also being sought abroad.

With over 27 years of dedicated service in the practice of Tibetan Medicine, he has attended many National & International Conferences; presented many papers on Tibetan Medicine & has number of published articles to his credit. He is also actively involved in the Men-tsee-khang's Clinical research studies including Diabetes Mellitus and Cancer. Dr. Dorjee also served as the chairman of the Central Council of Tibetan Medicine, Dharamsala, under the Tibetan Govt in exile from year 2007 to 2009.

In recognition of his outstanding contribution in the field of Alternative Medicines, Dr. Dorjee was awarded Gold Medal & Gem of Alternative Medicine in 1995 & 1996 from the Indian Board of Alternative Medicine, Calcutta. He is also a recipient of the International Award of Excellence, from American Organization of Intellectuals INC. New York, USA.
