I had undergone vigorous training in the art of pulse diagnosis, urine analysis and identification of hundreds of Medicinal Herbs, plants, minerals used in the compounding of Tibetan medicine. Pharmacology was integral and important aspect of Tibetan medicine and had special training on the techniques.

Mahajan, Former chief Justice of India. • 1983-85 - Under the aegis of the then Finance Minister of Nagaland, Mr. Nuyulle, visited several remote places of the state holding various medical camps-giving free consultations and treatments to several hundreds of poor and needy people. • 1986 - Started my branch clinic in Mumbai (Bombay) at the request of many of my patients, although it was not always possible to make regular visits because of ever increasingly busy schedules apart from having to attend to my regular patients at Delhi where patients from all parts of the country visit for consultation and treatment. • 1989-90 - At the request of Mr. Arvind Bhai Kamdar, visited villages of Bhav Nagar and Ahmedabad in Gujarat to hold medical camps giving consultation and treatment over 500 patients during the week long camp. • 1993-94 - Under the auspices of Potala Tours & Travels Pvt.
