Dr. Ngawang Jinpa was enrolled into the Tibetan Medical & Astro. College in 1993 and in 1998, he was graduated with a Kachupa Degree in Tibetan Medicine. He has served as a Residential Doctor at three different branch clinics from 1999 to 2013 for nearly 15 years. In 2011, he was awarded the Menrampa Degree on clearing Promotional Exam successfully. In 2012, appointed as the coordinator from the south branch and still working as committee member of Thuk-Dham project.

In 2013, he was transferred to the Body, Mind and Life Department of Tibetan Medical & Astro Institute, Dharamsala. Since then, he has been actively involved in researching on the Tibetan Medicine perspective on “**Sok or Life**” and has compiled a book on the same. He is one of the resource person for all the courses on mental healthcare organized by the BML Department. In 2017, he was speaker of 5<sup>th</sup> Body, Mind and Life Conference and presented on the prevention of Mental Disorders from Tibetan Medicine perspective.

In 2015, appointed as the member of the ‘Committee for Prevention of Diseases’ and has edited two booklets titled “Prevention of Stomach Cancer” and “Prevention of Piles Disorder” to his credit. And appeared several time on CTA’s Tibet TV programme to talk about disease prevention method through Sowa Rigpa Tradition.

Currently working at Documentation and Publication Department, during which he had Completed and edited “ KEMDREL” based on the hand written and previously version of the same and as printed in 2018.

In September 2019, he was elected for the 6<sup>th</sup> Executive member of the Central Council of Tibetan Medicine (CCTM) and currently serving as the Gen. Secretary of CCTM.
