རི་སྒོ་བའི་རྒྱ་ས།	<p>Dr. Tenzin Deche Kartsang born in 1962 is a qualified doctor in Sowa Rigpa, Tibetan Medical System. He has been working with Men Tsee Khang as a Tibetan doctor since 1986. From 1992 onwards he has been working as chief medical officer in various branches of Men Tsee Khang including 3 years in Europe. At present he is the Chief Medical Officer of one of the biggest Branch Clinic of the Institute situated at Nizamuddin, New Delhi where he sees from 70 to 80 patients per day.</p> <p>He obtained his medical and pharmacology degrees of Sowa Rigpa from Tibetan Medical and Astro Institute, Dharamsala in Himachal Pradesh. He studied under the guidance of eminent masters such as late Prof. Bhashi Phuntsok Wangyal, late Dr. Lobsang Choephel, late Dr. Tenzin Choedrak, the Chief Personal Physician of His Holiness The Dalai Lama and late Prof. Tenzin Namgyal etc.</p> <p>Dr. Kartsang qualified his BTMS (Kachupa) degree in 1986 and five-year degree course in Sowa Rigpa Pharmacology in year 1991. He obtained his Menrampa Chungwa (MD) degree in 1998 and Menrampa Dingwa (MD) degree in 2009.</p>

Researches:

Conducted research on effectiveness of Tibetan Medicines (Sowa Rigpa) on various diseases such as:

- Arthritis & Rheumatism in Europe & same was documented.
- Monitoring effectiveness on Cancer Patients.
- Supervisor for research on Diabetic Patients in Delhi.

Dr. Kartsang represented Men Tsee Khang for several National & International programs like:

- First ever organized Tibetan Festival in Moscow, Russia
- The World Peace Congress in Thailand.
- The yearlong programme to observe 50 years of Tibetan in Exile, he was one of the main member of the organizing committee.
- Given consultation to over 100 Russian guests who came to India for teaching by H H The Dalai Lama.
- Participated in the US Embassy New Delhi Health Camp held at US Embassy New Delhi and gave consultation to about 80 staff members of Embassy and their guests in one day

There many of his patients got benefited from several European Insurance companies. ➤ Chief Examiner of Men Tsee Khang 7th batch final year of Kachupa Degree students and the entrance exam for the new batch for Kachupa degree ➤ Since 1992 he has been working as Chief Medical Officer of various branches of Men Tsee Khang including the in Netherlands in Europe for 3 years. ➤ He was a consultation committee member for Northern India Railway Station at New Delhi for several years. <p>Dr. Kartsang was the first doctor from Men Tsee Khang (Sowa Rigpa) to be posted as residential doctor in Europe for 3 years in late 90s with Dutch Foundation for Tibetan Medicines (NSTG) In Netherlands. This was the only legalized clinic for Tibetan Medicines in whole Europe. There he did research on effectiveness of Tibetan Medicines on Arthritis & Rheumatism and same was documented. Along with the research he also gave consultation to over 10,000 western patients. Results were good and he became member of the Natural Therapy Board (VNT) in Europe. Due to excess of patients from other European countries, NSTG has to open 2nd clinic in Emst for patients coming from Belgium, Luxembourg, Germany, Austria and France etc. In the mid of year 1999 after completion of his deputation period in Netherlands, he return back to India.</p> <p>Awards:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
