

Dr. Tsering Thakchoe Drungtso

Dr. Tsering Thakchoe Drungtso joined T.C.V (Tibetan Children's Village), a school started under the auspice of His Holiness the Dalai Lama to get his high school education. While in school he actively participated in various co-curricular activities. He was always a school debating champion and winner of many essay competition. He was awarded the best essay prize in a contest held during the International Year of Tibet by the Department of Education, CTA (Central Tibetan Administration).

He had been the founding member and editor of the Lower T.C.V school magazine "Donmey", editorial board member of Upper T.C.V school magazine "Losel Melong", and also the founding and editiorial member of Tibetan Medical and Astrological College magazine "Gangri Langtso". Since 1998-2004, he had been a consultant of English edition of "Gangri Langtso" magazine.

In 1996, after five arduous years studying the vast and rich subject of Tibetan Medicine, Dr. Drungtso graduated as a fully-fledged Tibetan medical practitioner with distinction. He has had the unparallel opportunity to be accepted into the inner traditions of Tibetan Medical Science and Buddhism under the expert eyes of various Tibetan Lamas, masters, experts and scholars including his late father.

He practiced Tibetan Medicine under the expert eyes of late Dr. Lobsang Wangyal and the late Dr. Kunga Gyurmed Nyarongshar, both of whom served as a personal Physicians to His Holiness the Great 14th Dalai Lama of Tibet.

Dr. Drungtso obtained "Menrampa Chungwa (MD) degree in Traditional Tibetan Medicine in the year 2009. He served MenTsee Khang (Tibetan Medical and Astrological Institute) nearly Seventeen years in various capacities as a lecturer of the college, translator of the main Tibetan Medical text rGyud –bZhi (The Four Tantras Medical Treatise) and Member Secretary of the High Level Medical and Astrological Council (HLMAC).

Dr. Tsering Thakchoe Drungtso served as the 2^{nd} term executive member of the CCTM from 2007-2010 and the Chairman of the 3^{rd} term executive member of the CCTM from 2010-2013.

Dr. T.T.Drungtso had represented Men Tsee Khang at various seminars and travelled extensively in Asia and Europe and the West for both healing and teaching purpose.

He guided many international students, doctors and researchers in their study of Tibetan Medicine and translated number of medical research papers and books in to Tibetan and English.

Since 2015, he founded the Drungtso Tibetan Medical and Astrological Center (DTMAC) at Dharamsala and since then he is serving as a Director and Chief Medical Officer of this center. He is also one of the main resource person and faculty member of SIT (Study International), a global Learning program based in USA.

He was awarded the status of visiting research Associate Scholar and a member at the Darwin College, Cambridge, UK in 2005.

He received prestige Indian Achievers Award for Outstanding Professional Achievement and Inspiring Social Contributions at India-International Business Summit on 14th June, 2019 at New Delhi. He also received Asia Pacific Excellence Award 2021(International Educator Award), Saturday, 18th December, 2021, Radisson, Gurugram, Udyog, Vihar,

India.

Presently he is also working as a High Level board member of the Tibetan Terminology Standardization, a project under the department of Education, Central Tibetan Administration, CTA.
